The program starts Saturday, January 6th at Summit West Ski Area and continues for eight weeks, skipping February 17th and 24th, finishing on March 10th, unless weather forces postponement. If a cancellation occurs, we automatically extend the program the number of days missed. This program is open for adults and children.

Classes begin at 10:00 a.m. and are 2 hours long. Lessons are taught by Mini Mountain Ski & Snowboard School with twenty-six years of teaching experience in the greater Bellevue/Seattle areas. Students with no skiing or no snowboarding experience **MUST** take indoor lessons before going on snow. MM requires 6 indoor for skiing and 12 indoor for snowboarding or if the student is 6 years or younger. Indoor chairlift lessons may be used as part of this package.

Deadline for ordering passes is December 15, 2006. **Season rentals** may be obtained through Mini Mountain for a discount. Rental fitting can be done at Mini Mountain in Bellevue anytime after October 1, 2006 (prices below include tax).

Class Placement

What can you do at this time with few or no falls?

- ◆ **New Skier:**
No skiing experience.
- ◆ **Christie Skier:**
Can sideslip both ways. Finishes last half of turn with match skis. Skis easier slopes on big chairs.
- ◆ **Beginning Skier:**
Can go straight and stop. Some turning. Needs help on beginner chairlift.
- ◆ **Carving Skier:**
Can match skis in most turns with pole plants. Skis most advanced slopes.
- ◆ **Wedge Turn Skier:**
Links wedge turns. Skis independently on the beginner chairlift.
- ◆ **ATAC Skier:**
Skis all terrain and all snow conditions including deep snow and moguls.

- ◆ **New Snowboarder:**
No riding experience.
- ◆ **Fakie Boarder:**
Switches from regular to fakie while linking turns. Rides most advanced slopes.
- ◆ **Beginning Boarder:**
Can side slip on toe and/or heel edge. Rides independently on the beginner chairlift hill.
- ◆ **ATAC Boarder:**
Boards all terrain and snow conditions including deep snow and moguls.
- ◆ **Turning Boarder:**
Does toe/heel turns. Rides easier slopes on big chairs.

Please Note: Snowboarders must be 9 years or older. If your child is younger than 9 years and has prior snowboarding experience, they may be accepted into the program. Pre-approval is required. Contact Ed Kiser – 425.746.7547.

Participation Agreement & Liability Release

I (we) recognize that skiing/snowboarding are hazardous sports that can result in serious injury or death. I (we) voluntarily made a choice to participate in this activity and accept the risks inherent in skiing/snowboarding and in the ski area/mountain environment. I (we) accept my (our) responsibility to be informed, to behave prudently, to ski safely and to read and abide by the Skier's Responsibility Code and all other posted behavior notices. I (we) agree to **Release, Hold Harmless and Indemnify** Emerald City Sports Club, Mini Mountain Sports Center, the ski area and its/their employees, agents, volunteers, contractors, officers and owners from all claims for any damage resulting from any cause which arise out of participation in or travel to and from this ski/snowboard program. This release is binding as to any other persons, including family members, heirs and executors. This release does not apply to gross negligence or intentional acts.

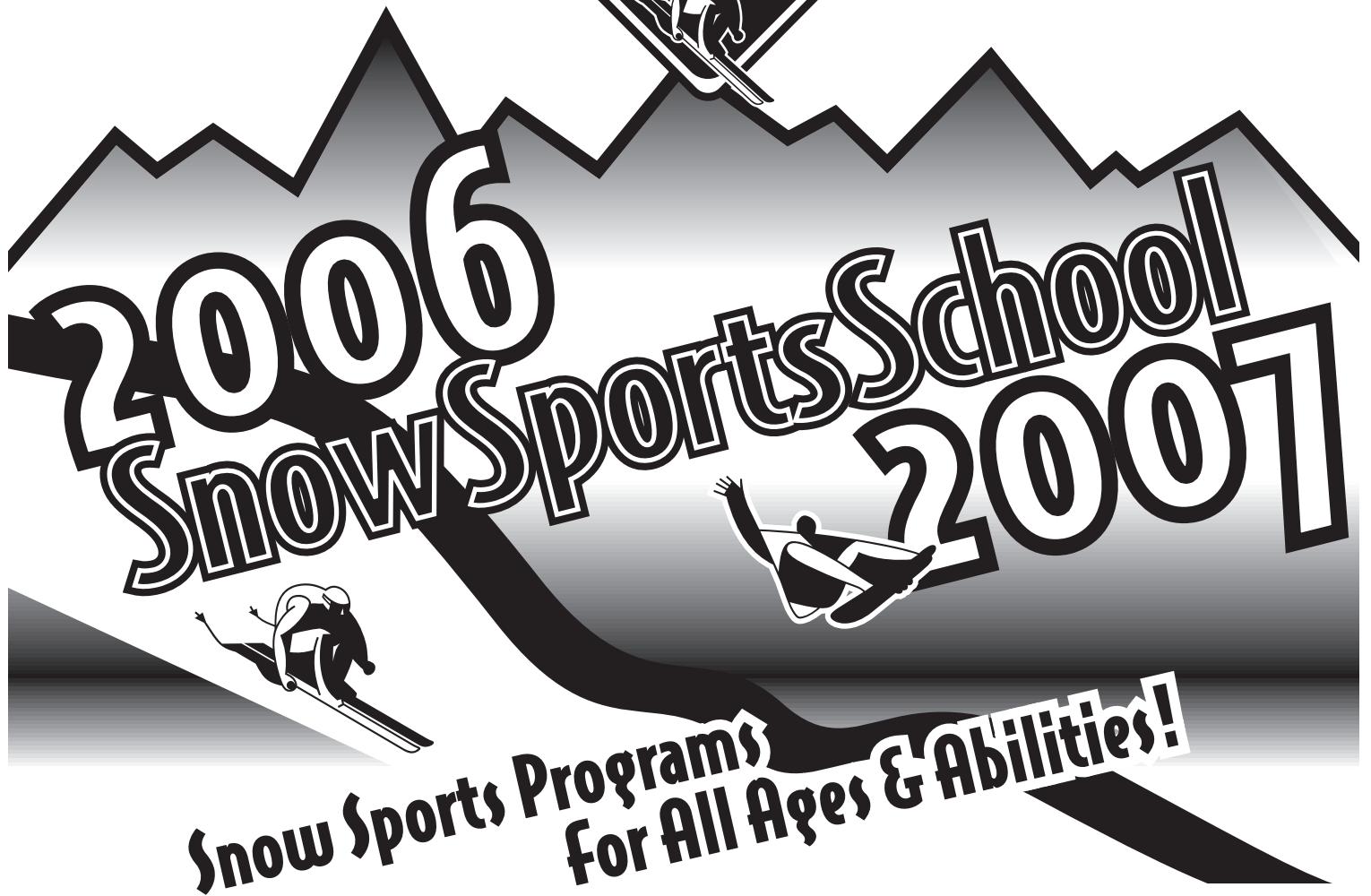
If I am signing on behalf of a minor I recognize that I may not release any claims the minor may have. However, I accept full responsibility for all medical expenses and/or damages incurred as a result of the minors participation in or travels to and from the ski program. I also agree to **Release, Hold Harmless and Indemnify** Emerald City Sports Club, Mini Mountain Sports Center, and the ski area and their employees, agents, volunteers, contractors, officers and owners for any claims brought by the minor.

Students will be expelled from this ski/snowboard program without refund for being willfully disobedient; possession, use or sale of tobacco, alcohol, or controlled substances; vulgarity; stealing; gambling; fighting; leaving the ski area or for using non-approved transportation. If the ski/snowboard program is canceled for a day(s), the program is automatically extended until the program is completed. If the program isn't completed by March 17, 2007, any remaining lessons will be converted into indoor lessons. There are no refunds or rollovers for on-snow lessons. Indoor lessons must be completed by September 30, 2007. Refunds are only considered if a student must withdraw based upon a doctor's written recommendation. Because of pre-season costs, a \$50.00 processing fee is charged to issue all refund checks.

Season's Pass - Summit at Snoqualmie

For Season information visit: www.summitatsnoqualmie.com. Pass applications will be mailed back to applicant. Please be aware tickets and passes are purchased through the Summit at Snoqualmie ONLY. Mini Mountain and Emerald City will not be responsible for your passes.

There are several methods to choose from to obtain your discounted Season's Pass:

1. If you had a pass last year, you can send the completed and signed application with payment to The Summit at Snoqualmie by December 15, 2006. Write on the application "Use last year's photo." Pass will be mailed back to student.*
2. If you did not have a pass last year, send a school photo or any picture that is wallet size or larger with your completed and signed application and payment to The Summit at Snoqualmie by December 15, 2006. Pass will be mailed back to student.*
3. If you had or did not have a pass last year, you can drive up to The Summit West Season Pass Office with your completed and signed application and payment. Get your picture taken or use last year's photo and they will give the pass to you right then.

* If you would like to receive your pass before the season starts, pre-register before October 31, 2006.
